



Protect yourself and your pets

Cases of wildlife rabies have been confirmed in your local area. To stop the spread and keep your family and pets safe, please follow these guidelines.

- If someone has been exposed to a potentially rabid animal, contact your local health unit, doctor or emergency department
- Let animal control officers deal with nuisance animals on your property
- Remind your children to stay away from unknown animals
- Vaccinate your pets and keep them away from wildlife
- Do not feed or relocate wildlife
- Do not keep wildlife as pets
